- And many more...

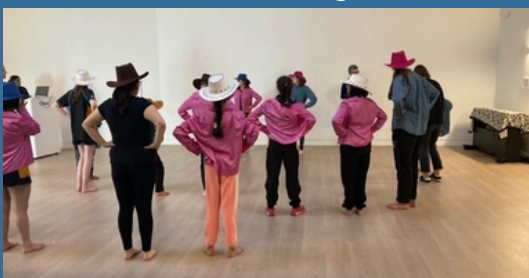
